Just a reminder that the last week before the Christmas Holidays is not funded as Wiltshire Council only fund the children for 38 weeks of the year and we are open for 39 weeks (17th to the 21st Dec will not be funded)

This means that all funded children can still access their sessions, but fees will apply. If your child usually does more hours than the 15 or 30 hours (which ever applies to you) these will still be invoiced even if you decide not to bring in your child during that week.
